NRF Assesses 12.5 km Robertsport-Madina Road Corridor

The National Road Fund of Liberia (NRF) is continuing its nationwide engineering inspections to assess and validate road works financed under the Annual Road Maintenance Expenditure Program (ARMEP).

In Grand Cape Mount County, the team reviewed the current condition of the 12.5-kilometre Robertsport-Madina corridor, including ongoing maintenance and rehabilitation activities.
